We do have a concession stand that serves hot dogs, chips, candy, sports drinks, etc. We are not responsible for lost articles—mark your belongings and protect them while in camp at all times. Bring tennis shoes for rainy day gym session when necessary.

Check-In Time: First day of each camp between 8:30 and 9a.m. Camp T-shirts will be distributed and a general orientation meeting will be given for both campers and parents from 9—10a.m.
