



## Accessing Gaming Revenues for your Little League Program

Little League British Columbia encourages each league to explore the possibility of receiving gaming revenue for the purposes of the League. The benefits can be significant, and will help leagues keep the registration costs down. Below are some links to the Provincial Public Safety and Solicitor-General's website which explains fully the process of applying, including an application form and what other documentation you need to provide at the time of the application.

**Please note that sports organizations must apply** after February 1. Deadline is May 31. Approved grants paid by August 31.
